Celebrate 150 Years of Frank Lloyd Wright

Frank Lloyd Wright is quite possibly the most famous American architect of all time, and 2017 marks the 150th anniversary of his birth.

Wright pioneered the "Prairie Style" of architecture and designed hundreds of houses, museums, and buildings throughout the country. Chicagoland is the leading destination for people to learn about Wright and see samples of his work. Oak Park, in particular, is home to the largest collection of Wright-designed structures in the world!

To celebrate this milestone, on **Thursday, November 9 at 7:00 pm**, the Library is hosting Laura Winkle from the Frank Lloyd Wright Trust who will give a "highly visual" presentation titled, Frank Lloyd Wright: The Chicago Years. Ms. Winkle will walk us through Wright's first twenty years in Chicago and its suburbs and explain how his experiences in the city would have a profound effect on his architecture, shaping the principles and philosophies that influenced his entire career.

At the conclusion of the presentation, the Library will hold a raffle. Attendees will have the chance to win one of two prizes: a pair of tickets for a guided tour of Wright's Home & Studio, or a copy of Patrick Cannon's book, Hometown Architect: The Complete Buildings of Frank Lloyd Wright in Oak Park and River Forest, Illinois.

New Fire Alarm System

The Library has a brand new fire alarm system. The work was begun

the end of August and completed on September 28 and final inspections and testing of the system were completed by the Village. Patrons may have noticed workmen on ladders, working in spaces above the ceiling tiles, but much of the work to replace the old system was done in the early mornings, before the library opened, to minimize disruption to patron areas since new wires had to be run throughout the building. With the new system operational, the Library board and director will turn their focus to the big HVAC replacement project scheduled for next spring.

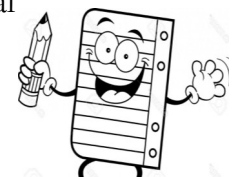

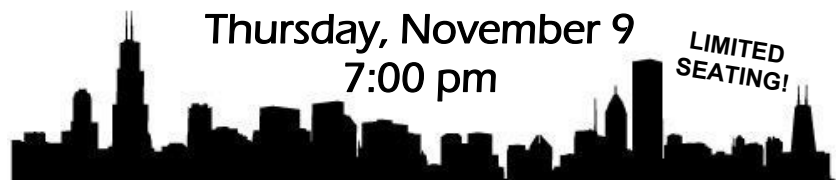
